This event is a FUNDRAISER for the two agencies, so there will also be a SILENT AUCTION! See you there!

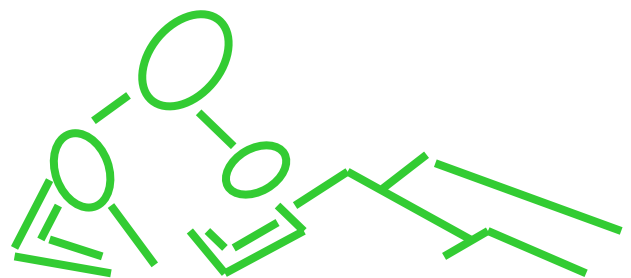
Location: The Corbin Center, 222 Center Drive, Corbin, just off the southern Corbin exit behind Applebees.
