The Leadership Academy is for:

- Parents/primary caregivers of children with emotional/social delays or behavioral health disabilities, AND
- Youth and Young adults that have a behavioral health disabilities. Youth must be at least 16 years old and be able to participate in the group process.

(IMPORTANT: All youth under 18, or who are over 18 and have a guardian, must have a parent or guardian that will attend the training with them.)

- Providers or agency partners that understand and support the “family-driven and youth-guided System of Care” and want to assist KPFC in moving forward in this effort.
