Youth Activity Track

Youth Leadership Track

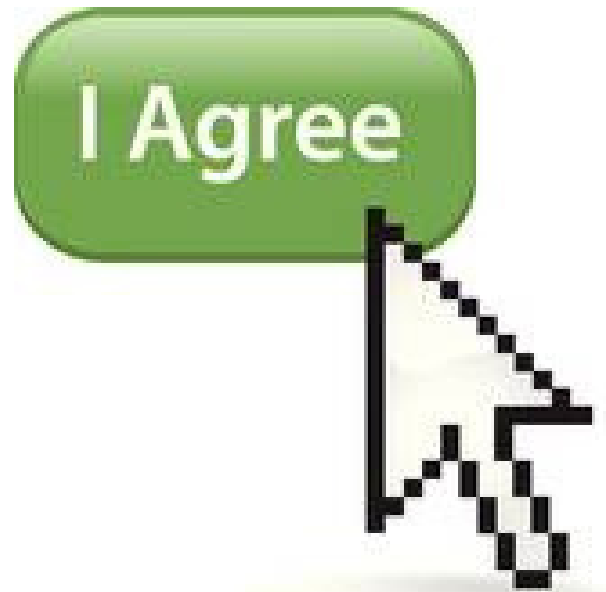

This track is for parents. It will include sessions on: recovery strategies, advocacy skills, and helping your child transition.

- Follow the 11pm curfew set by KPFC

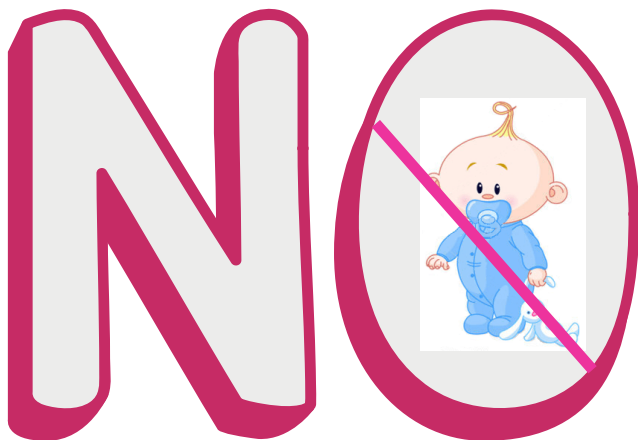
EXPECTATIONS
